Saturday, April 1st, 2017



WHAT: St. Augustine is the **oldest European city in the U.S.**, founded in 1565.

- You can see the **Castillo de San Marcos**, the most well preserved example of a Spanish fort in the U.S. with reenactments and real cannons.
- Walk through the Old Town and visit shops, tourist sites, and restaurants.
- Visit the beach!

WHERE: Meet at Norman Garage at **9 AM**. If you arrive late, the bus may leave without you, so get there early! We will get on the bus to leave around 7 PM and returning home around 9 PM. We will go to the beach first and then go to the city.

COST: You will need to buy a bus ticket for \$20 in cash, exact change, this week from 9 am to 12:30pm from Nate in Matherly 211. Don't forget to bring your Gator 1 ID! The passes are non-refundable and do not include cost of food and admission to the fort and other places.

What to Bring: You should bring about \$40 for museums and food. Bring \$7 cash if you want to enter the Castillo de San Marcos. Bring a swim suit, towel and sunscreen for the beach!

12:30 p.m.- Arrive at St. Augustine's Frank B. Butler Beach (5860 A1A S, St Augustine, FL 32080)

3:15 p.m.- Get back on bus to leave beach

3:30 p.m.- Leave for St. Augustine Welcome Center Bus Lot (3 Riberia St, St Augustine, FL 32084)

3:45p-6:45p Walking around Old City (eat dinner during this time)

7 p.m.- Get back on bus to leave St. Augustine

7:30 p.m.- Bus leaves St. Augustine

9:30 p.m.- Back at Norman Garage (please arrange for your own transportation)
